the **Vision and Voices** method

ACTS 11:5A,7

⁵ “I was in the city of Joppa praying, and in a trance I saw a vision. ⁷ Then I heard a voice telling me, ‘Get up, Peter. Kill and eat.’



How God's Spirit guides us...

the **Do what's Obvious** method

ACTS 11:19,22

¹⁹ Now those who had been scattered by the persecution that broke out when Stephen was killed traveled as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus and Antioch, spreading the word only among Jews.

ACTS 11:19,22

²² News of this reached the church in Jerusalem, and they sent Barnabas to Antioch.

How God's Spirit guides us...

the **Prophet in the House** method

ACTS 11:27,28

²⁷ During this time some prophets came down from Jerusalem to Antioch. ²⁸ One of them, named Agabus, stood up and through the Spirit predicted that a severe famine would spread over the entire Roman world. (This happened during the reign of Claudius.)

the **Have a Meeting** method

ACTS 15:28

²⁸ It seemed good to the Holy Spirit and to us not to burden you with anything beyond the following requirements.



How God's Spirit guides us...

the **Walk into a Wall** method

ACTS 16:6,7

⁶ Paul and his companions traveled throughout the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been kept by the Holy Spirit from preaching the word in the province of Asia. ⁷ When they came to the border of Mysia, they tried to enter Bithynia, but the Spirit of Jesus would not allow them to.

ACTS 16:8,9

⁸ So they passed by Mysia and went down to Troas. ⁹ During the night Paul had a vision of a man of Macedonia standing and begging him, “Come over to Macedonia and help us.”

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”
